

Tempe Union High Schools Education Foundation Scholarship Criteria “Glover Scholarship”

The “Glover Scholarship” was established by Eileen Glover after the passing of her husband. **Designated for a Career and Technical (CTE) Tempe High School student**, THREE scholarship awards of \$1,000 will be given on the basis of:

- Attending Tempe High School in a CTE program completer or on track to complete a CTE program upon graduation;
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 in a CTE course, 2.0 grade point average academically;
- Financial need; Submit your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) **or** list your family’s monthly household income and the number of people living in your household. Feel free to add any relevant comments pertaining to your financial situation;
- Plans to attend a technical school, community college or university;
- Plans to pursue a focus in one of the following areas:
 - Information technology, graphics design, culinary arts, business management, automotive, biotechnology, medical, health occupation, or construction;
- Essay of 250 words or less on “How this scholarship will help me reach my educational goal”.
- Include an official high school transcript with your application (Registrar’s Office).
- Include two letters of recommendations from teachers (1 is acceptable, 2 is preferred).
- Students with disabilities are encouraged to apply

- Demonstrate financial need by submitting FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) **OR** list your family’s monthly household income and the number of people living in your household. Feel free to add any relevant comments pertaining to your financial situation.
- List your plans to attend a technical school, community college or university;
- Which of the following areas do you plan to pursue:
Information technology, graphics design, culinary arts, business management, automotive, biotechnology, medical, health occupation, or construction;
- One (1) letter of recommendation required, two (2) letters are preferred (ex.: school counselor, teacher, etc.).
- Include an official high school transcript with your application (Registrar’s Office).

The scholarship recipient will be required to attend the Career and Technical Education awards ceremony.
